

## Windows 10 Home to Education Upgrade

1. Go to software.wisc.edu
2. Sign in with your NetID
3. Click “Microsoft for Personally-owned Computers”
4. Scroll down to Downloads and click the “Windows 10 Education for students” link

7. In the search bar, type “Activation”

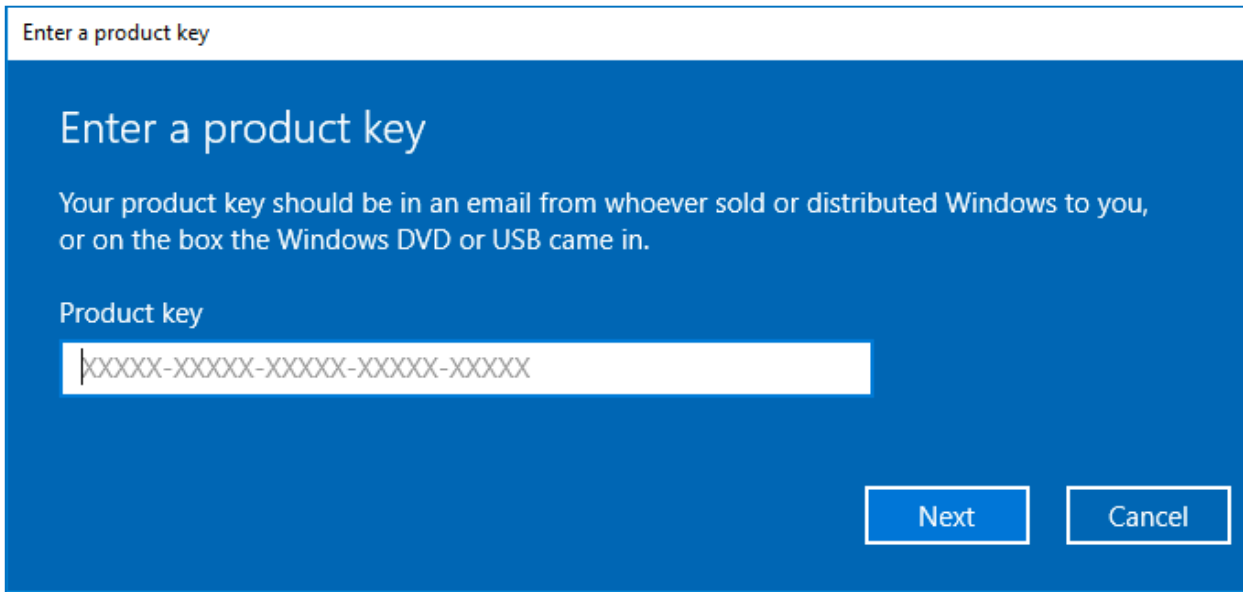

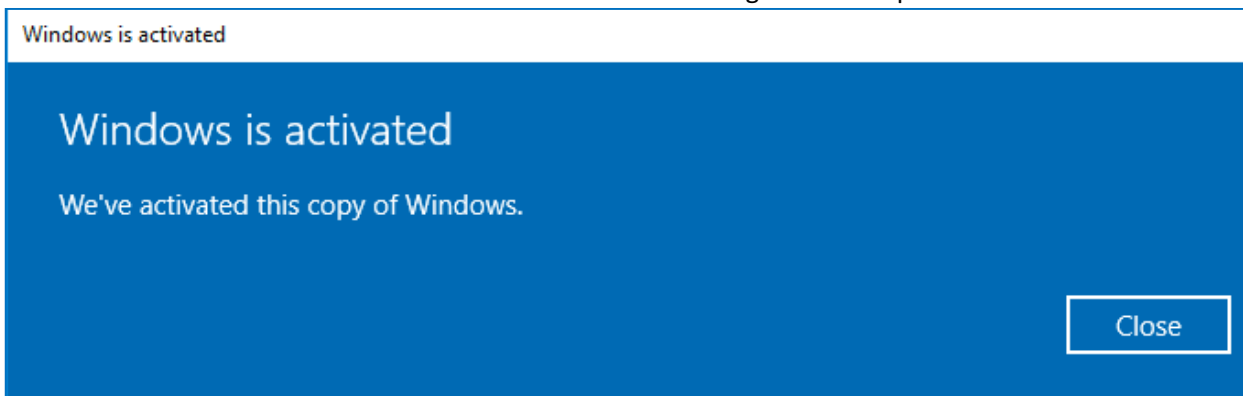

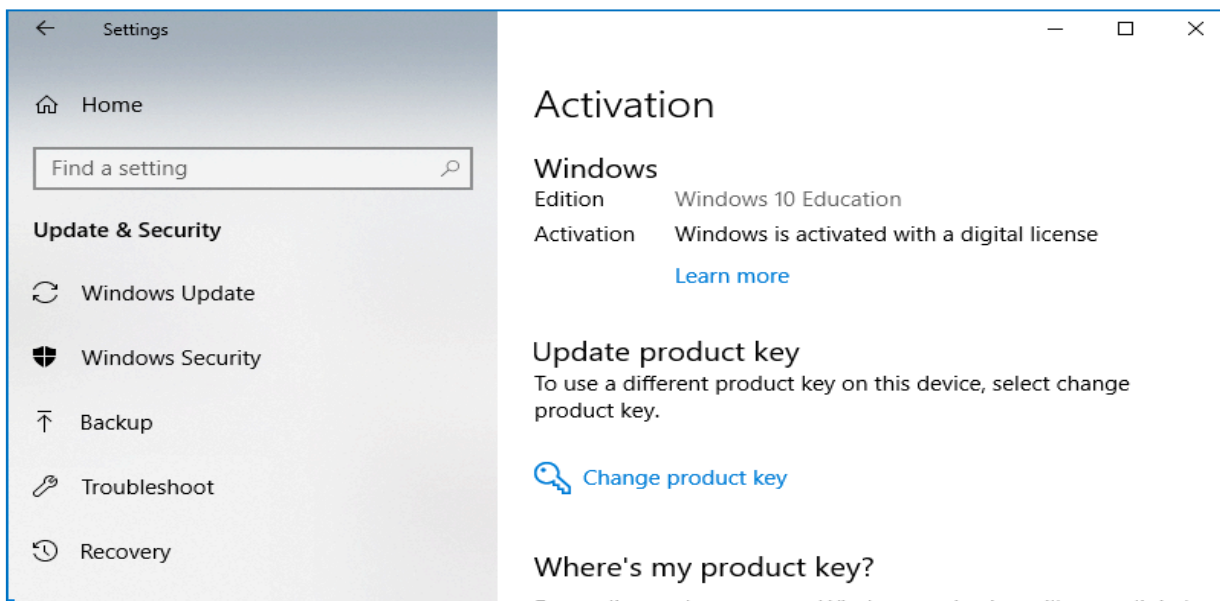
8. Click change product key and enter 25 character key from email from [wiscorder@doit.wisc.edu](mailto:wiscorder@doit.wisc.edu)



9. Follow the prompts to finish activating windows. It may take a while with a few restarts depending on your version of Windows 10. You should receive this message once complete:

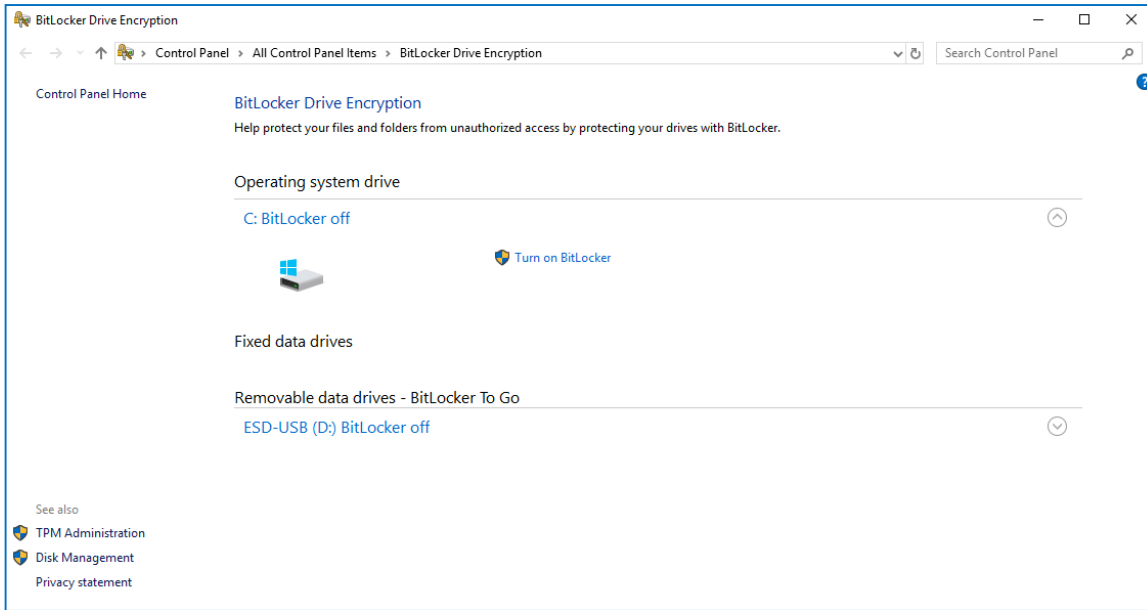


10. To double check you have Windows 10 Education, go back to the Activation screen which should display the Edition on the top of the page.

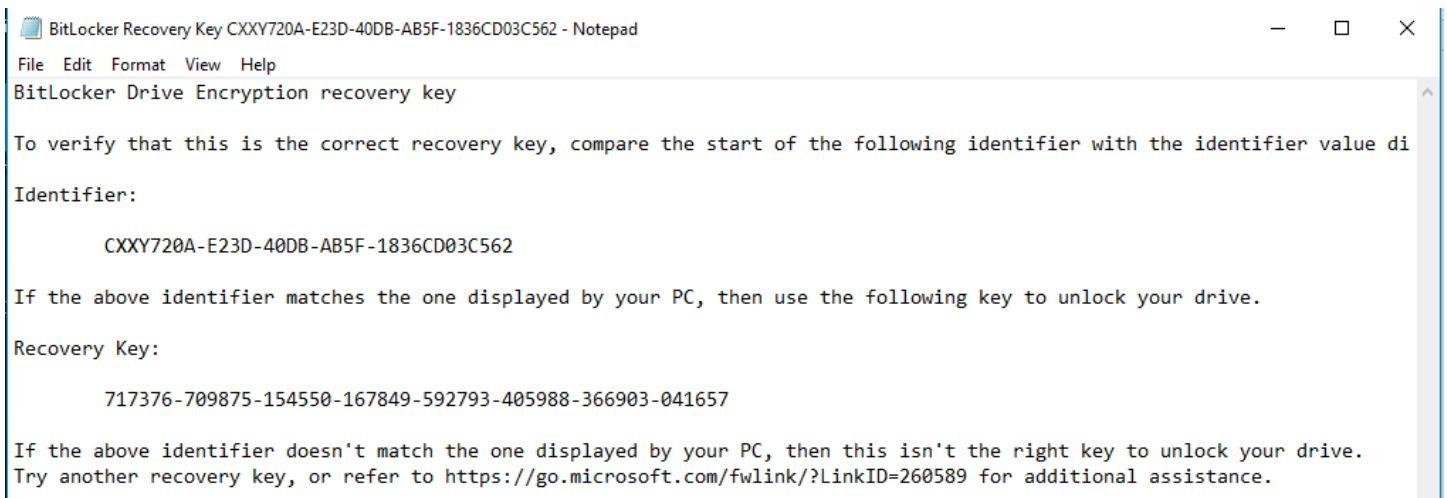
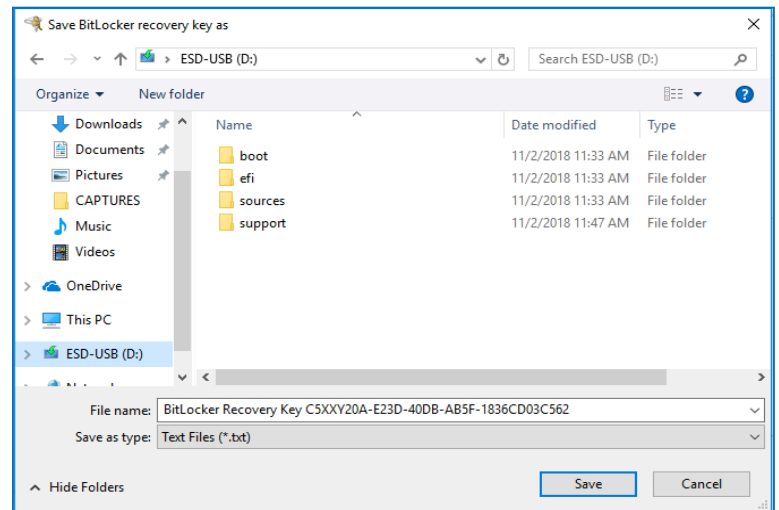
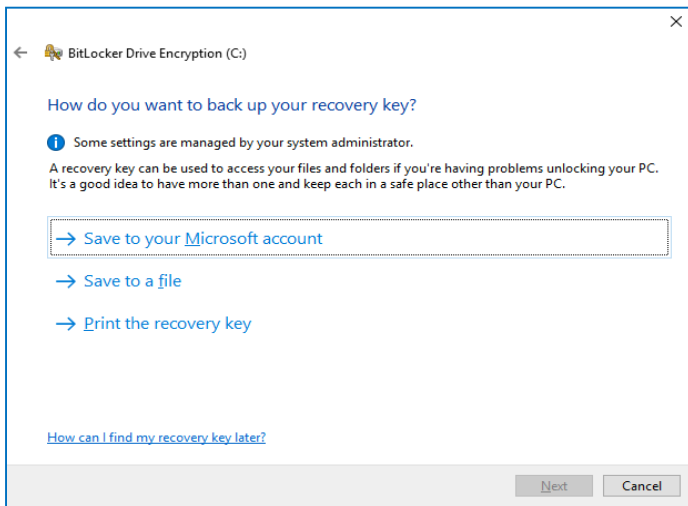


11. BitLocker encryption is necessary for UW Health remote access. To enable BitLocker, click the Windows icon and search “BitLocker”

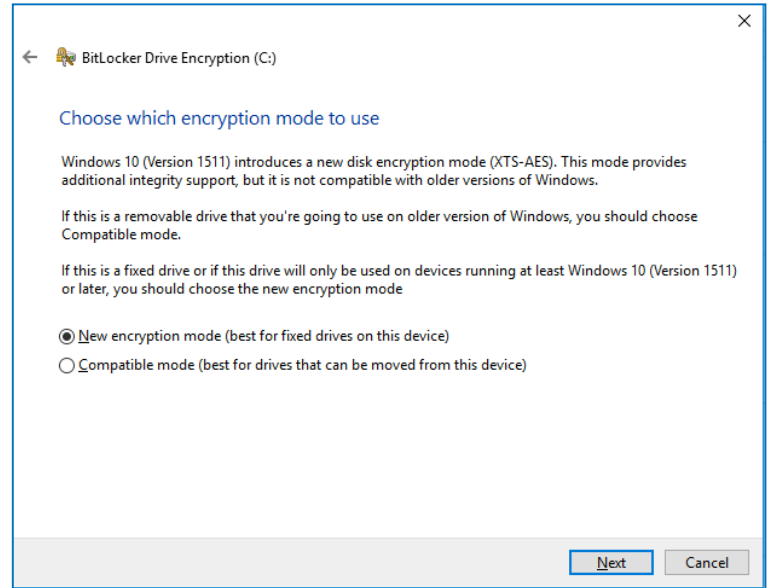
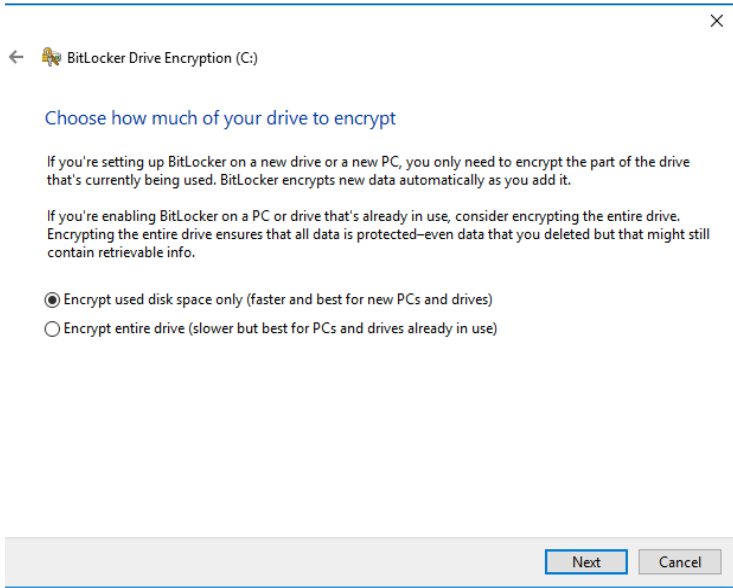


13. Click “Turn on BitLocker” and follow the on-screen prompts. It will require you to click “Next” a few times until you decide how to back up your recovery key. BitLocker creates a key to store in a secondary location for security reasons. Here, you will want to click “Save to a file” and save it to either print it out, save to a flash drive, Google Drive, or Box. ***For extra redundancy after saving it, you can take a picture of the open document with your phone to have it more easily accessible to you. If you lose the BitLocker key, there is no way to recover it.***



Once saved, follow the defaults on the next two pages (shown below).

14. Check the Run BitLocker system check and then click continue.



It will prompt you to restart the computer to start the encryption process. After restarting, log in and there will be a progress bar in the bottom right toolbar to monitor the progress. You can use the computer in the meantime as this encrypts in the background.
