



Add Network Printer to a Linux Computer

First find the printer name from within the print server (ex. [crb-4505-hp454dn](#))

Open the Printers Application, and select **+ Add**:




Then, open the **Network Printers** dropdown and click on **LPD/LPR Host or Printer**:




- Enter the **Host name**: [smph-prn.ad.wisc.edu](#)
- Enter the **Queue**: (Name of Printer) ex. [crb-4505-hp454dn](#)
- Then click Forward

When selecting driver, have **Select printer from Database** option selected, then have **Generic** selected and click forward:



Select **PCL 6/PCL XL** on the left and then select the recommended driver (Generic PCL 6/PCL XL Printer):



Enter the Printer details and click Apply:
