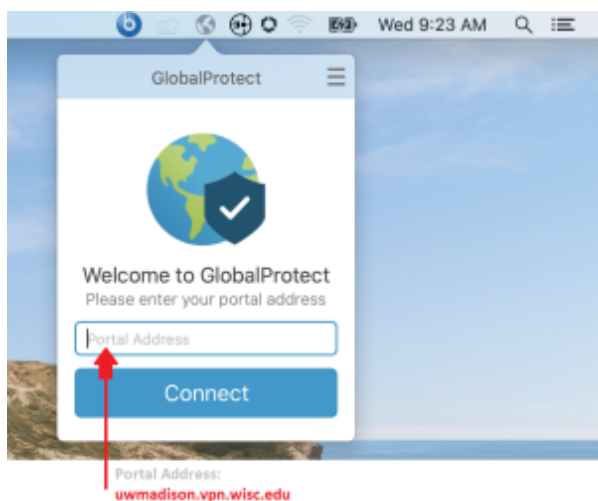

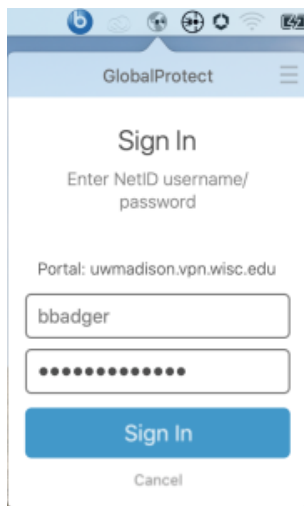

- Click the **GlobalProtect icon** on the *(top right)* menu bar.
- If it's not already there, enter the following **Portal Address**: uwmadison.vpn.wisc.edu

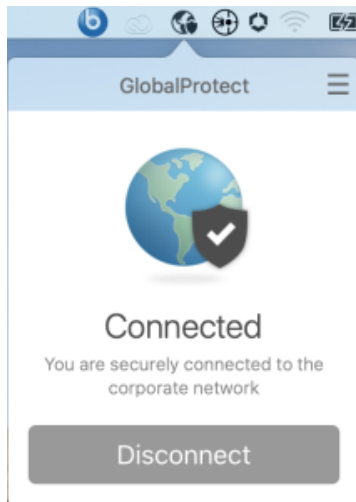


Note: The GlobalProtect icon looks like a light grey earth globe when its not connected.
